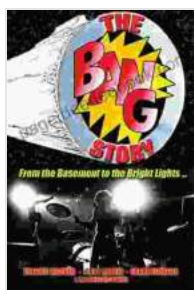


# From the Basement to the Bright Lights: A Journey to the Top

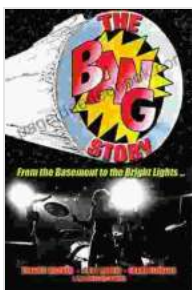
## **Tips for Success**

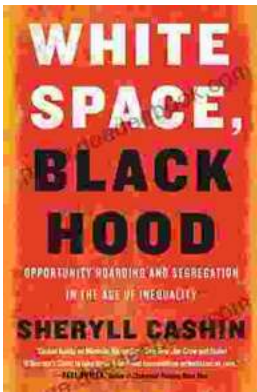
