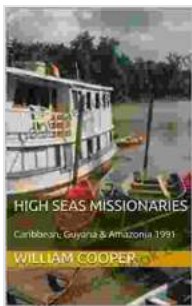


High Seas Missionaries: A Caribbean Guyana Amazonia Expedition (1991)

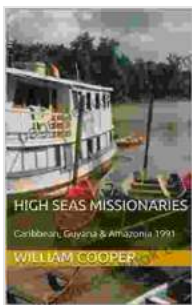

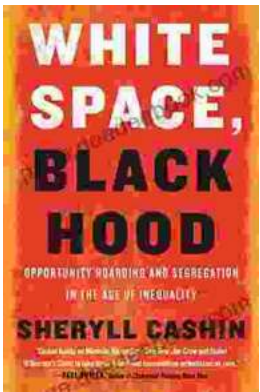
