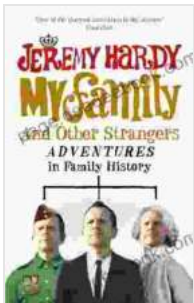


My Family and Other Strangers

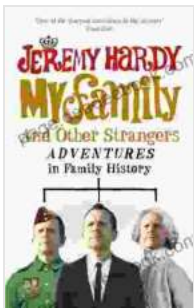

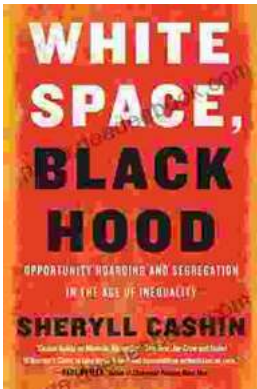
